What is Workism?

This course outlines the difficulties encumbered of Kerryn trying to gain successful employment and is designed for the general public to gain insight of how people with ASD/Asperger's Syndrome find it difficult to fit into the workplace.

What made you decide to write this new course on employment issues for people with AS.

There was a need to address society on the difficulties that people have with disabilities, therefore the course was developed to assist in this area.

Are there other Autism related courses on the market?

There is no other Adult Autism related course on the market at present apart from Aspektism. Workism is the follow on course from Aspektism.

What modules are there in Workism?

Dealing with Centrelink, Going for a job interview, Disclosure of disability, Teamwork and taking instruction, Conflict in the workplace, Job hunting & the person with ASD, Making lunch for work, and Tips for successful employment.

It all depends on the person, their impairment of disability and how they can live their day to day lives. It is also based on employer's education of ASD/AS in the workplace and whether or not, the employer is willing to accept the person with a disability/ASD/AS and allow them to go to work each day as many of us take for granted.

"In Australia alone, many people who have disabilities miss out on employment as it is a lack of understanding of these types of people and the disabilities they have."

"Education is vital for society to understand disabilities much greater than what it now anticipates".

That sounds exactly like my son/daughter is going through! How will I learn more about their ASD/AS?

Through a workbook called Aspektism for Teens/Adults, which is also available from this organisation.

How do I get support from these courses?
